

# Communication Authentication

Authentication codes, processes, or procedures are essential to any modern society. They are used in banking, business, military, and in interpersonal communications. Without them we would have no way to ascertain the identity of the entity/person who is communicating with us.

Imagine for a moment that you are powerful creator/god of extraterrestrial origin, outside the space/time continuum of your creation. You could give your message to your created beings, but how would you authenticate it, especially so that it could be passed down to future generations? Who could trust the message? You would be required to use multiple authentication codes to avoid doubt and confusion. And this is precisely what our Creator God has done with his word: the Bible - 66 books with over 40 authors, written over many generations.

The Bible is filled with many evidences of design - that of an integrated message system, the product of supernatural engineering. There are so many that it is impossible to show more than just a couple in this message. For example Chapter 5 of Genesis is just a genealogy of ten men. Study of the original roots of the names of these men in order (ie. Adam = Man), translated in order from the original Hebrew yields the following "*Man is appointed mortal sorrow, but the Blessed God shall come down teaching that His death shall bring the despairing rest.*" *Whoa!!! How did that happen?*

The genealogy of Jesus in Matthew follows a heptadic (seven [the "number of perfection"]) rule structure that defies random chance by 40,353,607 to one. The last 12 verses in Mark have over 34 heptadic features which defies randomness by 54,116,956,037,952,111,668,959,660,849 to one. A million supercomputers, composing 400 million drafts per second, would require over 4 million years to complete the assignment. This with only 34 features, yet there are actually 75.

Isaiah 53, regarded as a pinnacle chapter of prophecy related to Jesus, written about 800 years before his birth, reveal fascinating details that could not have been known even in its plain text. But coding in the original Hebrew text are the names of every disciple and follower of Jesus (except Judas) and the statement "Yeshua (Jesus) is my name".

There was only one day that Jesus allowed himself to be proclaimed King. That day was predicted according to Daniel 9:25 and recorded in Zechariah 9:9 and Luke 19:40. The decree of Artaxerxes initiated the prophecy which was completed precisely on the exact day Jesus rode the donkey, exactly 173,880 days from the prophecy as predicted (10th of Nissan or April 6, 32 AD).

Of the many astounding authentication devices in the Bible is the accurate prediction of the future from the distant past. Only a Creator/God outside our space/time could do this. Here is another example. There are over 330 prophecies in the Old Testament that predict the coming of Jesus and the circumstances of His appearance. Let's just look at 8 of them with their probability numbers. 1. Born in Bethlehem (100,000), 2. Presented as King on a donkey (100), 3. Return refused: Temple, Potter, etc. (100,000), 4. Betrayed for 30 pieces of silver (1000) 5. Wounds in the hands (1000), 6. No defense though innocent (1000), 7. Died among wicked, buried with rich (1000), 8. Crucified (10,000). The probability of just these eight is 10 to the power of 28. Imagine the probability of over 330 prophecies? That number is greater than the number of estimated atoms in the entire universe. According to mathematicians who specialize in statistics, this is no longer considered probability. They call it "**certainty**".

There are literally 1000's of authentication devices in the Bible: plain text, acrostics, metacodes, microcodes, els codes, etc. God made it very clear that the Bible is his Word.
