

Danzan Ryu Moral Principles

When I was reading my Bible the other day I came across a passage that could have been written by Master Okazaki, or Prof. Estes, but was in fact written by Paul in a letter to the Romans. Romans 12:9 -18 (New Living Translation)

***“Don’t just pretend that you love others. Really love them. Hate what is wrong. Stand on the side of the good. Love each other with brotherly love, and take delight in honoring each other. Never be lazy in your work, but serve the Lord enthusiastically. Be glad for all God is planning for you. Be patient in trouble, and always be prayerful. When God’s children are in need, be the one to help them out. And get into the habit of inviting guests home for dinner or, if they need lodging, for the night.*”**

If people persecute you because you are a Christian, don’t curse them; pray that God will bless them. When others are happy, be happy with them. If they are sad, share their sorrow. Live in harmony with each other. Don’t try to act important, but enjoy the company of ordinary people. And don’t think you know it all.

Never pay back evil for evil to anyone. Do things in such a way that everyone can see you are honorable. Do your part to live in peace with everyone, as much as possible.”

Does this describe you? Compare this to the Esoteric Principles of Master Okazaki. Compare it to the Code of Bushido. Do you see the similarities? As a Christian, Prof. Estes lived according to these principles. Master Okazaki lived and acted according to these principles, even before he converted to Christianity. Examine yourself!
